Status of Park Operations

(as of October 1, 2020)

The following facilities remain **CLOSED** to the general public:

- ◆ Park Commission Headquarters at the Cultural Center;
- ◆ All indoor facilities (private event rentals may be available if Executive Order restrictions permit);
- ◆ Cooper Gristmill & Grounds **(Trails and Parking Area Open);**
- ◆ Craigmear Recreation Area;
- ◆ Historic Speedwell;

The following facilities are open with **REDUCED** hours of operation:

- ◆ Fosterfields Living Historical Farm **(Drive-thru /Walk thru Tours –Thursday thru Saturday online registration only);**

- ◆ Great Swamp Outdoor Education Center, grounds and trails only (Wednesday thru Friday, 8:00a.m. to Sunset;

MAXIMUM CAPACITY FOR OUTDOOR GATHERINGS IS 500 PEOPLE (UNLESS FOR RELIGIOUS OR POLITICAL ACTIVITY)

PICNIC SHELTER USE IS 25% OF CAPACITY BUT NO MORE THAN 100 PEOPLE

INDOOR ROOM USE IS 25% OF ROOM CAPACITY

- ⇒ At this time all Park Commission Programs, Activities & Events have been cancelled (there may be a few in-person programs scheduled-please check website Calendar) for the remainder of the year. ***(For information on Virtual Programming and Drive-thru /Walk-thru Farm Tours visit www.morrisparks.net)***
- ⇒ Private Rentals and Park Permits may resume as per Governor Murphy's Executive Orders
- ⇒ Some Parking Areas are being limited at various parks/facilities due to a significant increase in use and to allow for social distancing.
- ⇒ Public Restrooms—15 of the Commission's stand-alone restrooms are open 7-days a week.
