Behavior Contract

This document is the behavior contract for the *Eureka! Historic Technology* and *All About Farms* summer camps, it outlines the responsibilities and privileges of all parties involved in camp. The document must be signed by both the camper and the camper’s parent or guardian and returned with the Registration Form.

The Historic Sites of the Morris County Park Commission will provide a safe, fun learning environment for the camper. All activities will be supervised by adults and have been designed by trained museum education professionals.

The Parent or Guardian of the camper will drop off and pick up the camper on time, be sure that they are prepared for camp, and dressed appropriately for the weather and the activities.

The Camper will have fun, respect others, be attentive to educators and counselors, and behave in a manner befitting a young person in a museum setting. This is an inter-personal contact free camp, meaning that campers are prohibited from physical contact with other campers. The camper promises to stay with his or her group and to follow all rules and regulations, both posted and given verbally, by the Morris County Park Commission and the Historic Sites’ staff.

Historic Sites camps will discipline based on a “3 Strike” system of the following levels:

First Offense: Verbal Warning

Second Offense: Removal from Activity

Third Offense*: Parent is called to Remove Camper from Camp

*In this case, the camper may or may not be allowed to continue camp for the remaining days. This action will be at the discretion of the coordinators. The consequences of this action may also affect future participation in this program.
