- By Thursday, September 1, artists must sign a hold harmless agreement and submit payment made payable to "MCPC."
 - Spaces will be either 6'x6' or 6'x4' and will be assigned on a first come, first served basis.
 - Artists must have someone at their station at all times from 12 noon - 4 pm and are required to interact with visitors, explaining their art and techniques throughout the event.
- It is recommended that artists offer works in a variety of price ranges, such as cards, small pieces, and large pieces.
