Campers at Camp Sunrise Lake experience days filled with new adventures, safe exploration, budding friendships, and memories that last a lifetime. Half of each day is spent at Sunrise Lake Beach Club swimming in the lake, playing on our inflatable obstacle course, the Wibit, taking turns going down the Zoom Floom slides, and building awe-inspiring sand castles. The other portion of each day is filled with age-appropriate sports, games, arts and crafts, and other fun activities.

Camp Sunrise Lake seeks to provide a safe, fun environment in which children can learn and grow. We look to foster leadership skills and encourage responsibility trying new things, confronting challenges, and working with a team, all while having a fun and exciting camp experience.

Camp Sunrise Lake welcomes campers age 5-11 and CITs age 12-14. Each week is limited to 50 campers and 16 CITs so early registration is encouraged!

OPTIONAL PROGRAMS

Afternoon Explorers: The only thing better than a day at camp, is getting to stay longer at camp! Afternoon Explorers can extend their camp day by 30 minutes and get picked up at 4:00pm. This means more GaGa, more arts and crafts, and more of your favorite camp activities. *Please note – Afternoon Explorers will not swim, use the Wibit, or have access to the beach.* Limit 10 campers per week.

Swim Lessons: Get extra swimming practice in a comfortable, familiar setting immediately after the camp day. Swim lessons run Monday-Friday from 3:30pm – 4:00pm. Parents are encouraged to attend to watch their swimmer’s progress!

- Intro Level
 - 5 & 6 year olds
 - Focus is on water safety
 - 5 spots available per week
- Beginner/Intermediate Level
 - 6 & 7 year olds
 - Focus is on refining skills and working towards passing the facility swim test
 - 5 spots available per week

RAINY DAYS

Based on current group sizes and protocols, we have enough covered locations or indoor spaces to run activities while avoiding close contact. Any day extreme weather is expected, MCPC will make a decision whether or not to run camp. This decision will be made and communicated to you in a timely manner. Our aim will be to notify parents/guardians by 6pm the night before to allow you time to make alternate arrangements. No refunds will be issued for rainy days.

CANCELLATIONS

In planning our camp programs, MCPC incurs many non-recoverable expenses on behalf of the participant. All cancellations must be put in writing.

If a cancellation is requested more than 30 days prior to the start of camp, 90% of the registration fee will be returned and 10% will be retained for administrative fees. If the cancellation is requested less than 30 days prior to the start of camp, refunds will be provided ONLY if the vacancy can be filled with another camper, less a 10% administrative fee. There will be no refunds for any days missed within a session by a camper.

MCPC reserves the right to cancel any camp session. In the event of a cancellation by MCPC, you will receive a credit to your household account (pro-rated daily if cancellation happens during the session), minus a 10% administrative fee. There are no refunds due to weather related closures.

OFFICE POLICIES

- Camp Sunrise Lake has a strict NO REFUND policy.
 - Spots are filled on a first-come, first-serve basis. Spots will not be reserved without completed paperwork and payment.
 - If you have any concerns or problems, please speak directly with the Camp Director. The Camp Director will then address the situation and correct the problem if possible. If further action needs to be taken, the MCPC Recreation Staff (Recreation Supervisor and Recreation Program Specialist) will become involved.
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CAMP POLICIES

- Due to the complexity of food allergies, we ask that all food brought to camp be NUT-FREE.
 - Lunch should be packed separately from snack.
 - No glass is allowed in lunchboxes. Please use plastic containers.
 - Pack a refillable water bottle, water will always be available.
 - Cell phones and all other forms of technology are NOT allowed at camp. We ask for parent cooperation with this, as technology hinders campers from a full camp experience.
 - Camp Sunrise Lake is not responsible for lost, stolen, or broken items. A lost-and-found will not be available.
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COVID GUIDELINES

Camp Sunrise Lake will continue to follow CDC and health department guidelines to keep camp as safe as possible for campers and staff. We have run safe, Covid-free camps in 2021 and 2022 and will follow similar guidelines this year.
