The Program: Our camp will have a strong emphasis on skating and fundamental hockey skills. Through the development of these skills, the program will lift the player to a level required for more competitive play. Camp instructors will teach innovative practice drills to help athletes develop their strength, agility, quickness, and flexibility. Skating performance training will include proper edge control, forward/backward starts, controlled turns and steps. Puck control drills, shooting, passing and receiving will also be a key component of instruction at our camp. Students will be taught team play concepts as well as developing a better understanding of individual skills. All players should have at least one year of playing experience.

Ice Time: Daily on ice instruction will consist of 3¾ hours for Mite through Bantam level player.

Enrollment will be limited to 35 skaters and 4 goalies to ensure maximum instruction.

Example Daily Itinerary:

9:30 - 10:30 am Power Skating
11:00 - 12:15 pm Stickhandling/Shooting/Passing
12:30 - 1:30 pm Lunch, Recreation
1:45 - 3:15 pm Team Play, Controlled Scrimmage

Lunch Program: The arena's snack bar offers a lunch plan for students attending camp (additional fee). Students are also welcome to bring their own lunches which will be held in the main office until lunch break.

Requirements:

1. Student must be between the ages of 6 to 14 years old. Certificate of Birth may be required to verify age.
2. A doctor's verification indicating that the student is physically and mentally capable to participate is required by all students.
3. Medical Insurance – The Morris County Park Commission does not provide medical insurance for students. In the event of illness or injury requiring treatment, hospitalization, and/or surgery, the family medical insurance must be used. The Park Commission strongly recommends that students be covered by some form of personal medical insurance.
4. Check-in for all students on the first day of school: Time – Monday morning one (1) hour prior to the start of the assigned group class. All students late or absent from class cannot make up their ice time. All students are encouraged to be on time.
5. It is required that all students put personal identification on equipment as the school is not responsible for loss of equipment.
6. Equipment – All students are required to have the following equipment for school:
