POLICIES

Office Policies:

- Adventure in Nature camp has a strict **NO REFUND, UNLESS WE CAN FILL YOUR SPOT** policy. If your spot is able to be filled, a refund will be processed minus a 10% administrative fee.
- Spots are given on a first come, first serve basis. No one will be entered into our database and spots will not be reserved without completed paperwork and payment.
- Campers are aged 2 - 14. CIT's must be 14 - 17 years old.
- If you have any concerns or problems, please speak directly with the Camp Counselors. The Camp Counselors will then address the situation and correct the problem if possible. If further action needs to be taken, the Manager of Environmental Education will become involved.

Camp Policies:

- Cell phones and all other forms of technology are NOT allowed at camp. We ask for parent cooperation with this, as technology hinders campers from a full camp experience.
- Adventures in Nature Camp is not responsible for lost, stolen, or broken items.
- For the older kids camps: Counselors and groups leave Pyramid Mountain promptly at 9:15 a.m. on the days that the Adventure in Nature Camp is going offsite. If there is an instance in which you will be arriving after this time, please call Pyramid Mountain at 973.334.3130 so that check-in arrangements can be made.
