The Speedwell Image Collection is comprised of materials donated or purchased from a variety of sources including family members Alfred Slocum Vail (HS1974.86, HS1992.1-61) and William Van Vleck Lidgerwood (HS1979.31-35, HS1991.169-181), Morristown Town Historian and early Speedwell Village Trustee Carl Scherzer (HS1970.67, HS1975.9-110, 1983.18), other early donors (HS1974.89, HS1976.76-95, HS1979.91, HS1982.8), later donations and items found in collection (HS2001.3-4, HS2008.4, HS2013.1, 8-22, HS2017.12), and Speedwell Village and Morris County Park Commission purchases (HS2000.9, HS2000.56-68, HS2010.2, HS2012.4, HS2012.15, HS2013.4, HS2013.7, HS2015.1).

Biographical Note

A significant portion of the Speedwell Image Collection is related to the family of Stephen Vail (1780-1864). Stephen married three times, to Bethiah Youngs (1778-1847; m. 1801), Mary Carter Hedges Lidgerwood (1805-60; m. 1848), and Phoebe Ann Miller (1818-1881; m. 1862). Stephen had four children who survived to adulthood: Harriet Vail Canfield (1802-28), Alfred Vail (1807-59), George

Vail (1809-75), and Sarah Louise Davis Cutler (1811-87). Alfred Vail was a machinist and inventor. Along with Samuel Morse, Alfred was central in developing and commercializing American telegraphy between 1837 and 1844. George Vail was a Democratic Party politician who represented New Jersey's 4th congressional district in the United States House of Representatives from 1853 to 1857. George was partner in his father's Speedwell Iron Works and managed the business for several years following Stephen's death. Harriet married Dayton Canfield (1821) starting the Canfield line, and Sarah married Dr. Silas C. Cutler (1829) starting the Cutler line, and when Dr. Silas C. Cutler died (1843) married Whitfield D. Hurd (1854) starting the Hurd line.

Stephen Vail's second wife Mary Carter Hedges Lidgerwood had two children previous to her marriage with Stephen; John Hedges Lidgerwood and William van Vleck Lidgerwood. John Hedges Lidgerwood marries Stephen Vail's granddaughter Harriet Bethiah Vail Cutler. The Collection contains images of Harriet Lidgerwood and their children. The couple had seven children. Another of Stephen Vail's granddaughters, Sarah Cecilia Cutler, marries Theophilus Hunt Andress (1865), another branch of the family represented in the Image Collection.

Included in the Collection are images which are connected to the history of the site, significant events or individuals associated with Historic Speedwell. Included in this grouping are images that relate to Samuel Morse, who along with Alfred Vail, made the telegraph a practical invention, as well as other images of the telegraph and related telecommunication technology. Also included in the collection are images related to Moses Rogers, captain of the SS Savannah. The SS Savannah was one of the first steamships and one of which Stephen Vail and the Speedwell Ironworks was involved in production and installation of its steam engine.

The Collection additionally contains images related to Moses Estey, his family and descendants as related to the Moses Estey House, which along with the L'Hommedieu House and Ford Cottage were moved to Historic Speedwell in the late 1960s for their continued preservation. The Collection contains images of their movement to the site.

Scope and Content Note

The Speedwell Image relate to the Vail Family, their descendants and history, and the development and eventual decline of the Speedwell Iron Works as well as 19th century industrial development in general. Additional images relate to local Morristown history in the 19th and early 20th century as well as the clothes and customs of people of the 19th and early 20th century. The Collection also represents examples from nearly all types of photographic types from the earliest daguerreotypes in the 1840s through modern digital photography.

Arrangement

The Speedwell Image Collection is organized into 6 series

Series 1: Daguerreotypes and Ambrotypes

Daguerreotypes and Ambrotypes relating to the history of the Vail Family as well as images of people from the mid to late 19th century.

Series 2: Glass Plate Negatives

Glass Plate Negatives containing images of Speedwell Iron Works in the 19th and early 20th century as well as members of the Vail Family, and sites and locations around Morristown in the 19th and early 20th century.

Series 3: Buildings and Grounds

Images relating to the Speedwell Iron Works in the 19th and early 20th century. As well as shots of the general surroundings of the Iron Works and the Lake and Dam near the Iron Works. Several images show specific buildings on the Speedwell site such as the Factory and the Foundry of the Iron Works.

Series 4: Family Photos

Images relating to the Vail family and their descendants, including shots of Alfred Vail, Stephen Vail, James Vail, Mary Lidgerwood, Grace Lidgerwood, William Lidgerwood, Harriet Lidgerwood. The Vail gravesites and the Vail family and descendants at home and in local surroundings are also contained.

Series 5: Site/Local Association

Images of Morristown in the 19th and early 20th century, images relating to the creation of the telegraph, images relating the SS Savannah and its creation, images relating to the Moses Estey Family.

Series 6: Albums

Albums of photographs including among others an album by Thomas Vail on his Roxbury, MA house, an album on Western Union by James Vail, an album on Shelter Island by Grace Lidgerwood and an album on Old Speedwell by James Vail.
