### Historical Note

The Wortman Mill is located in Pottersville (Tewksbury Twp.), New Jersey. It is a three and a half story frame mill with a two story, large frame addition which utilizes the Lamington River. The original structure was built in the 1750s by William Willet, and the Mill provided grain to Washington's Army during the

Revolutionary War. Willet went bankrupt after the war when Continental currency was devalued and sold the Mill to Samuel Potter in 1782, after whom Pottersville is named. The Mill ceased operation in 1957.

## Scope and Content Note

The Wortman Mill Papers are a collection containing financial information from the Mill. This collection includes invoices and receipts for services rendered to the Mill and ledgers created by the Mill employees and owners.
